<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Ask and answer questions about what they read.</p> <p>Identify main topic and key details of a text.</p> <p>Retell familiar stories, including key details.</p> <p>Name the author and illustrator in a story and explain their roles.</p> <p>Use phonics to read with accuracy and fluency.</p> <p>Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to tell a story with one or more events.</p> <p>Print many upper- and lower-case letters.</p> <p>Recognize and name end punctuation (e.g., period, question mark).</p> <p>Communicate and work with others about what they read and write.</p>	<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Compare numbers and objects up to 10.</p> <p>Write any number, count objects and tell how many up to 20.</p> <p>Compare two groups and tell which one is greater, less or if the groups are equal.</p> <p>Sort objects based on what they have in common, count the number of objects in each group and order them by amount.</p> <p>Recognize that a number of objects are the same in any arrangement or order.</p> <p>Identify, describe, compare, model and compose two dimensional and three dimensional shapes.</p>	<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Determine the relationship between an object's characteristics and its resulting motion when a force is applied.</p> <p>Determine the best way to move an object based on its characteristics.</p> <p>Classify objects by those seen in the day sky, the night sky, and both.</p> <p>Communicate the changes that take place in the day and night sky using pictures and words.</p>	<p><i>All students should know and/or be able to:</i></p> <p>Correctly use words and phrases related to chronology and time. (now, long ago, before, after, today, tomorrow, yesterday, first, last, next, day, week, month, year, past, present, future.).</p> <p>Identify Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas as national holidays and describe why it is celebrated.</p> <p>Explain that maps and globes show a view from above.</p> <p>Explain that maps and globes show features in a smaller size.</p> <p>State the street address, city, state, and country where they live.</p>
