Spring 2024 End of Grade Georgia Milestones Assessment System testing window opens soon, and we are making final preparations for a successful testing season. Our testing window opens April 22, 2024 and closes on May 1, 2024. As we finalize our plans for testing, we wanted to share some information with you.

Testing sessions can be lengthy, and we want to ensure students have the energy and stamina needed for the testing period.

Further, as a parent, you are a critical partner in ensuring that your students have a positive outlook and frame of mind about testing. As testing approaches and throughout the testing window, take extra time to encourage your student and offer words that instill confidence in their abilities and perseverance to ensure they arrive at school feeling good about themselves and have a positive outlook on the day.
