



Kindness Week Activities November 11th-15th

Monday, November 11th:

- Kick off Kindness Week and Start with Hello Program.
- **Students and Staff can wear a red, white or blue shirt in honor of our Veterans. (No jeans for students or staff)**
- Poster Contest (Posters will be displayed outside of the counseling office and judged on Friday, Nov. 15th)
- Veterans Day Presentation will be shown to students during homeroom.
- The Act of Kindness for the day is to thank a Veteran for their service.

Tuesday, November 12th:

- **Students and staff can wear a green shirt with uniform bottoms in support of “Start with Hello” (No jeans for students or staff)**
- Start with Hello promise pledge sheets will be passed out during homeroom. Pledge sheets can be turned in at the pledge table in the commons during lunch on Wednesday to be hung on our pledge wall.

Wednesday, November 13th:

- **“Go Blue Day”- Students and staff around the county will be wearing blue for World Kindness Day. Our students and staff may wear a blue shirt with uniform bottoms. (No jeans for students or staff)**
- Students will receive a “Kindness Pass it On” sticker and are encouraged to show an act of kindness toward another person. Kindness can be shown by giving others positive affirmations.
